President

Manoj was elected as CAPA President in November 2017 and will serve until November 2019. He has been involved with CAPA since May 2014 and was India's representative on the CAPA Board since October 2015. He also chaired the Public Sector Financial Management Committee from 2016-2017.

Manoj is a Chartered Accountant (CA) and is a Partner of Fadnis & Gupte Chartered Accountants. Manoj has been active in the accountancy profession in India since 2001 being an authority on Indian Accounting Standards and has been instrumental in their convergence with the International Financial Reporting Standards of India. He was President of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) for years 2015-16. He was previously a chair of the Small and Medium Practices Committee of the South Asian Federation of Accountants (SAFA) and a Director of XBRL India as a nominee of ICAI to promote the use of XBRL. He was a member of the National Advisory Committee on Accounting Standards and the Corporate Law Committee constituted by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India. He was also nominated by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India as a member of its Audit Advisory Board. Manoj is currently a member of the Small and Medium Practices Committee (SMPC) of the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC).

As President, Manoj chairs the CAPA Board and general members meetings.



Chen Yugui
Deputy President | Director – China

Chen was elected as CAPA Deputy President in November 2017 and will serve until November 2019. He is also China's representative on the CAPA Board, and represents the Chinese Institute of Certified Public Accountants (CICPA), a role that he previously held from 2003 to 2005.

Chen is the Deputy President and Secretary General of CICPA, positions he has held since 2010 and 2002 respectively. He holds a PhD in economics and began his career with the Ministry of Finance (MOF) of China in 1986. Prior to joining CICPA, he was the Deputy-Director General of the Accounting Regulatory Department in the MOF. Chen has extensive knowledge and experience having been involved in the development of China's accountancy profession particularly in the areas of policy design and reform, standard setting and convergence of Chinese standards with international ones, regulation of the Chinese profession, and international cooperation. He is also active internationally having served as a Board member of IFAC from 2003 to 2009 and 2013 to 2015, and as Deputy President of the 30th ISAR (Intergovernmental Working Group of Experts on International Standards of Accounting and Reporting) in 2013. Chen is currently also a Director of the Office of CPA Examination Committee of MOF, Vice Chairman of the MPAcc Steering Committee, and Vice President of the Accounting Society of China. He was awarded an Outstanding Achievement Award by ACCA in 2013.
